Recently the amount of stress I was under was starting to take my legs out from under me and the information that you supplied me with gave me the confidence to reach out for assistance when I was honestly questioning my future going forwards. I honestly don't know how to thank you for all the assistance, but I will continue to push forward toward future endeavors."
